

Do You Qualify for Emergency Assistance?

Step 1. Determine Eligibility

Household income cannot exceed the chart below.

Family of one (1)	\$10,400
Family of two (2)	14,000
Family of three (3)	17,600
Family of four (4)	21,200
Family of five (5)	24,800
Family of six (6)	28,400
Family of seven (7)	32,000
Family of eight (8)	35,600
For each additional person, add	3,600

Step 2. Required Documentation

- Valid Oklahoma driver license or Oklahoma picture identification
 - Verification of Oklahoma residency for six months
 - Proof of family income (pay stub)
 - Receipts documenting expenses for last 30 days
 - Social Security cards for all persons in household
- Proof of emergency (Cut-off notice for utility or eviction notice for rental assistance)
