

Notice of Funding Availability for the 2017 Continuum of Care Program Competition

All applications, including those applying for renewal funding or for new permanent housing bonus funds, must be entered into e-snaps and submitted by August 29, 2017 in order to be considered by NE OK COC. This is in compliance with Notice of Funding requirements that the COC establish an internal deadline no later than 30 days before the September 28, 2017 application deadline for submittal of the Collaborative Application to HUD.

The only potential for new projects in NE OK COC is through the Permanent Housing Bonus funds. \$66,026 is available to applicants interested in applying for Permanent Housing Bonus funds for 1) New permanent supportive housing projects meeting the requirements of DedicatedPLUS or those serving 100% Chronically Homeless individuals and families; 2) Rapid Re-housing projects serving **homeless** individuals and families coming directly from the streets or emergency shelters, and includes persons fleeing domestic violence situations and other persons meeting the criteria of paragraph (4) of the definition of homeless; 3) Joint TH and Permanent housing-Rapid re-housing projects and 4) Expanding COC funded PSH projects. (Please read the NOFA for the requirements for these components)

NE OK COC can submit one or more applications for the Permanent Housing Bonus with its Collaborative application.

If you are interested in applying for these funds, you must review the Notice of funding, the regulations, application instructions and become familiar with the program requirements. **If you intend to apply for Permanent Supportive Housing Bonus funds, please send me a summary of the amount you are considering, what the funds will be used for and what populations you will serve.**

Applications must be prepared and submitted in e-snaps on line, so you must register and be able to access e-naps to apply.

Note that NE OK COC must approve the projects, but new projects submitted will go into national competition for the funds, with no guarantee that the applicant will be awarded such funds as HUD makes the final determination regarding project funding awards.
